AQUA (SPRING WATER), MENTHOL CRYSTALS, GLYCERIN (VEGETABLE DERIVED), PHENOXYETHANOL, CHLOROPHENSIN, CAPRYLYL GLYCOL, CARBOMER, TRIETHANOLAMINE, ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL, ALLANTOIN, ALOE VERA (ALOE BARBADENSIS), CAMPHOR OIL (CINNAMOMUM CAMPHORA), PURE SPEARMINT ESSENTIAL OIL (MENTHA VIRIDIS).

Section 3 – Hazards Identification

Emergency Overview: This is a personal care or cosmetic product that is safe for consumers, professionals, and others under its intended and reasonably foreseeable use.

Potential Health Effects:

Skin Contact: Not expected to be irritating. Slight tingling affect may occur. If irritation occurs following intended use or prolonged contact it is expected to be mild and transient.

Eye Contact: Avoid direct contact with eyes. Contact may cause irritation. Some redness and/or stinging may occur. Rinse well.

Ingestion: Product used as intended is not expected to cause gastrointestinal irritation. Accidental ingestion of undiluted product may cause mild gastrointestinal irritation with nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea. Please consult your doctor if this occurs.

Inhalation: Not expected to be irritating to the respiratory system. Not volatile therefore limited inhalation exposure anticipated. Avoid prolonged usage. Wear a mask if you have respiratory problems and/ or take regular breaks in a suitably ventilated environment.

Section 4 – First Aid Measures

- Skin Problem:** Discontinue use of product. Apply cold compresses to affected areas to relieve any discomfort. If discomfort persists, contact a physician
- Eye Contact:** Thorough rinsing for 10 minutes of the affected eye with water is recommended. If discomfort or irritation persists, contact a physician.
- Ingestion:** Accidental ingestion of product may necessitate medical attention. In case of accidental ingestion dilute with fluids (water or milk) and treat symptomatically. Do not induce vomiting. - Packaging:** High Density Natural Plastic Bottle / Jar.

- Amount of Use:** Use as required. Avoid excessive use.
- Body exposure:** Use as required. Avoid excessive use.
- Frequency:** Use as require. Avoid excessive use.
- Time of exposure:** Can be left on. Rinse if over exposed.
- Other Recommendations:** The product should be used within 12 months of opening. The shelf life is 3 years from date of manufacture.
